Kitt Peak National Observatory hosts one of the world’s largest collections of telescopes. Its domes, silhouetted against Arizona’s sunset, symbolize the ongoing search for other worlds.

Pluto was discovered at Lowell Observatory (founded in 1894 by Percival Lowell) in 1930 before it was downgraded to everyone’s favorite dwarf planet in 2006.
